

# Ph.D. Degree Programme (Full-time and Part-time)

## Study Scheme Applicable to students admitted in 2018-19

### 1. Coursework Requirement

- (a) Excluding COMM 8200, students are required to complete a minimum of 30 units of courses for graduation.

- (b) COMM 8200  
Students are required to take COMM 8200 every term starting from the time of admission, throughout the preparation of thesis, until its completion. Students will gain the units each time they pass COMM 8200.
- (c) Students should at least have one refereed international conference presentation that requires submission of full paper (e.g. Annual Conference of the International Communication Association, Annual Conference of the Association for Education in Journalism and Mass Communication, National Communication Association Annual Convention or other equivalent conferences) and one single-authored or coauthored refereed Chinese or English-language journal article of any tier accepted/published before their graduation.

### 2. Qualifying Examination

- (a) Qualifying examination  
Advancement to Ph.D. candidature is conditional upon passing qualifying examinations. The examinations consist of three parts. Part I is on Research Methodologies, Part II is on Communication Theories and Part III is a Proposal Defense.

- (b) Every year we have a fixed timetable for PhD students to take qualifying examinations. The examinations time cannot be changed unless for specific reasons.
- (c) A student will be discontinued from studies if s/he cannot pass the qualifying examination.
- (d) Applicable to students admitted on 1 August 2010 and thereafter:  
Students are required to pass the qualifying examination within the maximum period as listed below:

With research Master's*:	Full-time	30 months

\*With effect from 2014-15 intake, except (a) research M.Phil. degrees and (b) other research master's degrees offered by UGC-funded institutions, all other master's degree, including those from the mainland, will be regarded as non-research master's degrees and such applicants will be given a normative study period of 48 months. The University has the authority to decide whether the degree possessed by an incoming student is a research master's degree or not, and such decision will be communicated to the student through the letter of admission.

### 3. Study plan

Students must submit a study plan, with the advice of the supervisor, for the approval of the Graduate Panel of the Board of School of Journalism and Communication within six months after registration. The Division Head will help the student search for a supervisor within the first semester of study.

### 4. Thesis

- (a) Thesis proposal  
A full-time Ph.D. student must submit a thesis proposal by the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> term of the 3<sup>rd</sup> year whereas a part-time Ph.D. student must submit a thesis proposal by the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> term of the 4<sup>th</sup> year. Students are NOT allowed to change their thesis topic after the proposal defense (unless under special circumstances).
- (b) Thesis supervisors  
Students are NOT encouraged to change their supervisors after the 2<sup>nd</sup> academic year begins (unless under special circumstances).
- (c) Students are required to submit a research thesis and pass an oral examination for graduation.
- (d) Thesis Monitoring Courses are listed below: COMM 5250, COMM 6110, COMM 8200.

### 5. Other Requirements

- (a) A student who obtains a cumulative grade point average (GPA) below 2.0 in the preceding term or receives a failure grade in thesis monitoring courses (for Research Postgraduate Programmes) will be put on academic probation. For details, please refer to Clause 13.0 "Unsatisfactory Performance and Discontinuation of Studies" of the General Regulations Governing Postgraduate Studies which can be accessed from the Graduate School Homepage: <http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/gss>.
- (b) Complete an Improving Postgraduate Learning (IPL) module on "Observing Intellectual Property and Copyright Law during Research". This will be an online module and relevant information can be accessed from the website: <http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/clear/prodev/ipl.html>.
- (c) With effect from the 2017-18 intake, all research postgraduate students are required to complete an online Research Ethics Training (RET) module on "Publication Ethics" and obtain a valid Publication Ethics Certificate for graduation. ### 6. Unsatisfactory Performance

A student whose thesis/portfolio is not passed but re-submission is allowed and re-examination is required must re-write and re-submit the thesis/portfolio to the satisfaction of the Thesis/Assessment Committee before being recommended for the award of degree. Such re-submission must be made within twelve months from the date of the official notification of the result of the first examination and within the student's prescribed maximum period of study. Only one re-submission of thesis/portfolio is allowed.

### 7. Remarks

With the approval of the Division Head, in lieu of the courses on the elective course list, students can take other courses within and/or outside the Division of Communication.

#### (2) COMM 8200

哲學博士生在完成論文前，必須每學期修讀 COMM 8200 論文撰寫課程，每次修讀而獲及格成績，均可獲得學分。

- (3) 畢業前，學生必須於最少一個審稿制度而需要呈交全文的國際會議 (例如 Annual Conference of the International Communication Association, Annual Conference of the Association for Education in Journalism and Mass Communication, National Communication Association Annual Convention 或其他同等水平的會議)中報告論文，以及出版(或已接納刊登)一份以中文或英文撰寫的獨著或合著論文。

#### 二、資格考試

##### (1) 資格考試

研究生通過資格考試後，即獲得博士候選人資格。資格考試分為三部份：第一部份為研究方法；第二部份為傳播理論；第三部分為論文開題報告。

- (2) 學院會在第一年開學前訂立資格考試的時間表，除非有特別理由，否則資格考試時間不可更改。
- (3) 研究生必須通過資格考試，否則將被退學。
- (4) 適用於 2010 年 8 月 1 日後入學的研究生：研究生必須分別在入學後一定時間內通過資格考試：

擁有研究碩士學位*：	全日制	30 個月
	兼讀制	42 個月

沒有研究碩士學位*：	全日制	42 個月
	兼讀制	58 個月

\*在 2014-15 年度或之後入學的學生，除了擁有 (a) 研究式哲學碩士，和 (b) 大學教育資助委員會撥款資助的院校的研究碩士的學生外，其他擁有碩士學位的學生包括來自內地的，將被視為非研究式碩士，而有關申請人的常規修業期為 48 個月。大學全權決定研究生所獲之學位是否屬於研究式碩士學位，是項決定將經入學通知書知會研究生。

### 三、 研讀計劃

研究生須於入學後六個月內，經論文導師指導完成研讀計劃，並提交予學部通過。在入學第一個學期，學部主任會協同學選定論文導師。

### 四、 論文

- (1) 除非特殊情況，否則研究生在通過論文大綱的口試後，不得再更改論文主題。全日制的研究生須於第三學年的第一學期提交論文大綱，兼讀生則要在第四學年的第一學期提交論文大綱。
- (2) 除非特殊情況，否則學部不鼓勵學生在第二學年或之後更換論文導師。
- (3) 研究生必須如期提交論文及通過口試，方可畢業。
- (4) COMM 5250、COMM 6110 及 COMM 8200 皆為輔導研究生撰寫論文的課程。

### 五、 其他要求

- (1) 研究生的累計平均積點如在 2.0 以下，或在論文指導科目(適用於研究式課程的學生)取得不合格成績，該生次學期將被列為試讀生。詳情可參閱「研究生總學則」(General Regulations Governing Postgraduate Studies)第 13 條「成績低劣及退學」(Unsatisfactory Performance and Discontinuation of Studies)，此學則已上載於研究院網頁：<http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/gss>。

### 六、 論文不獲通過

若同學的論文不獲通過，他／她必須在接獲通知的 12 個月內（而且必須是大學指定的最長修業期內），修改並重新提交論文予論文委員會評核，獲得通過後，方可畢業。每位同學只能重交論文一次。

### 七、 備註

如獲學部主任批准，哲學博士生可選讀學部以內/以外的其他科目，以取代選修科目。
