(b) COMM 8200 Thesis in Progress

Students are required to take COMM 8200 every term starting from the time of admission, throughout the preparation of thesis, until its completion. Students will gain the units each time they pass COMM 8200.

(c) Students should at least have one refereed international conference presentation that requires submission of full paper (e.g. Annual Conference of the International Communication Association, Annual Conference of the Association for Education in Journalism and Mass Communication, National Communication Association Annual Convention or other equivalent conferences) and one single-authored or coauthored refereed Chinese or English-language journal article of any tier accepted/published before their graduation.

2. Qualifying Examination

(a) Qualifying examination

Advancement to Ph.D. candidature is conditional upon passing qualifying examinations. The examinations consist of three parts. Part I is on Theory and Methodology, Part II is on Area of Specialization and Part III is a Proposal Defense.

- (b) Every year we have a fixed timetable for Ph.D. students to take qualifying examinations. The examinations time cannot be changed unless for specific reasons.
- (c) A student will be discontinued from studies if he/she cannot pass the qualifying examination.
- (d) Students are required to pass the qualifying examination within the maximum period as listed below:

With research Master's*:	Full-time	30 months

*With effect from 2014-15 intake, except (a) research M.Phil. degrees and (b) other research master's degrees offered by UGC-funded institutions, all other master's degree, including those from the mainland, will be regarded as non-research master's degrees and such applicants will be given a normative study period of

be regarded as non-research master's degrees and such applicants will be given a normative study period of 48 months. The University has the authority to decide whether the degree possessed by an incoming student is a research master's degree or not, and such decision will be communicated to the student through the letter of admission.

3. Study plan

Students must submit a study plan, with the advice of the supervisor, for the approval of the Graduate Panel of the Board of School of Journalism and Communication within six months after registration. The Division Head will help the student search for a supervisor within the first semester of study.

4. Thesis

(a) Thesis proposal

A full-time Ph.D. student with research Master's degree must submit a thesis proposal by the end of the 1st term of the 3rd year whereas a part-time Ph.D. student must submit a thesis proposal by the end of the 1st term of the 4th year. Students are NOT allowed to change their thesis topic after the proposal defense (unless under special circumstances).

(b) Thesis supervisors

Students are NOT encouraged to change their supervisors after the 2nd academic year begins (unless under special circumstances).

- (c) Students are required to submit a research thesis and pass an oral examination for graduation.
- (d) Thesis Monitoring Courses are listed below: COMM 5250, COMM 6110, COMM 8200.

5. Other Requirements

- (a) Students must fulfill the Term Assessment Requirement of the Graduate School. For details, please refer to Section 13.0 "Unsatisfactory Performance and Discontinuation of Studies" of the General Regulations Governing Postgraduate Studies which can be accessed from the Graduate School Homepage: https://www.gs.cuhk.edu.hk/.
- (b) A student must achieve a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.0 in order to fulfill the graduation requirement, unless special approval is granted by the Graduate Council.
- (c) Complete an Improving Postgraduate Learning (IPL) module on "Observing Intellectual Property and Copyright Law during Research". This will be an online module and relevant information can be accessed from the website: http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/clear/prodev/ipl.html.
- (d) Complete an IPL module on "Research Data Management Training". This is an online module and relevant information can be accessed from the website: https://www.cuhk.edu.hk/clear/download/IPL-Researchskills.pdf. Students are required to complete and pass the module in their first year of studies, with effect from the 2022-23 intake.
- (e) Students are required to complete an online Research Ethics Training (RET) module on "Publication Ethics" and obtain a valid Publication Ethics Certificate for graduation. Relevant information can be accessed from the RET website at https://www.research-ethics.cuhk.edu.hk/web/.

6. Unsatisfactory Performance

A student whose thesis/portfolio is not passed but re-submission is allowed and re-examination is required must re-write and re-submit the thesis/portfolio to the satisfaction of the Thesis/Assessment Committee before being recommended for the award of degree. Such re-submission must be made within twelve months from the date of the official notification of the result of the first examination and within the student's prescribed maximum period of study. Only one re-submission of thesis/portfolio is allowed.

7. Remarks

With the approval of the Division Head, in lieu of the courses on the elective course list, students can take other courses within and/or outside the Division of Communication.

二、 資格考試

(1) 資格考試

研究生通過資格考試後,即獲得博士候選人資格。資格考試分為三部份:第一部份為理論及方法;第二部份為 專業領域;第三部分為論文開題報告。

- (2) 學院會在第一年開學前訂立資格考試的時間表,除非有特別理由,否則資格考試時間不可更改。

三、 研讀計劃

研究生須於入學後六個月內,經論文導師指導完成研讀計劃,並提交予學部通過。在入學第一個學期,學部主任會協助同學選定論文導師。

四、論文

- (1) 除非特殊情況,否則研究生在通過論文大綱的口試後,不得再更改論文主題。擁有研究碩士學位的全日制的研究生須於第三學年的第一學期提交論文大綱,兼讀生則要在第四學年的第一學期提交論文大綱。
- (2) 除非特殊情況,否則學部不鼓勵學生在第二學年或之後更換論文導師。
- (3) 研究生必須如期提交論文及通過口試,方可畢業。
- (4) COMM 5250、COMM 6110 及 COMM 8200 皆為輔導研究生撰寫論文的課程。

五、 其他要求
